**Selection Procedure**

(iii) The tenure with ONGC will be upto 30.6.2010. (iv) Candidates should carry all original testimonials and caste certificates applicable for Central Government Services and should submit an attested photocopy of their relevant Educational certificates and documents and a recent passport size photograph at the time of interview.

**Other terms and conditions** for the contractual engagement are as follows: (a) The tenure with ONGC will be upto 30.6.2010. (b) The selected candidates would be required to work for 6 days in a week in two shifts, including emergency duty as decided by the Incharge Medical. (c) Notice period for one month would be required to be given from either side for termination of contractual engagement, if terminated prior to the stipulated tenure period. (d) Engagement on contract will be subject to medical fitness. (f) Contract agreement, specifying terms and conditions, will be signed by the selected candidates.
