- (b) In case large numbers of applications are received, Management reserves the right to call candidates having better experience profile/ higher percentage of marks only.
- (c) Application with incomplete information and/or not accompanied with photocopies of original certificates, in support of age, educational qualification, experience and caste (for SC/ST/OBC categories) along with their application will be rejected.
- (d) Application received after last date for receipt of applications, will neither be entertained nor returned and MRPL will not be responsible for any delay whatsoever.
- (e) Reservation of posts for SC / ST/ OBC (Non-creamy layer) / PH and relaxation thereof as per Government Directives.
- (f) Age Relaxation for SC/ST/OBC: 5 years for SC/ST & 3 years for OBC. Physically Challenged candidates shall get age relaxation of 10 years.
